I hope the New Year has started off well for everyone. Things are going well for the City as some projects wrap up and others are getting started.

We just finished a complete rebuild of McClung Street. There were many weather delays along the way due to the cold, snow and rain, but the final result is fantastic. This project also patched several potholes and base failures on Johnson Rd. As the weather warms up we will continue our road maintenance. We plan to add a chip seal to Johnson Rd, and once school is out for the summer we will address Wildcat Drive.

We have just begun a project to add a backup generator to our **water wells**. This will allow us to pump water into our system during **power outages**. With this generator added to the recent **water tower expansion**, our water system will be first class. We now have everything in place to get our **water supply** rated as superior by the State of Texas. We hope to finalize this rating in the near future, and we will place signs around the City once this rating is completed.

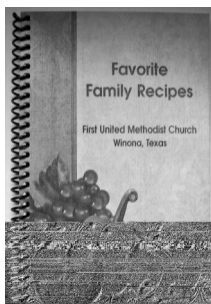
We are also actively pursuing options for a city park.
